Notice Concerning Revision of Dividend Policy and Revision of Dividend Forecast (Increase in Dividends) for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31, 2027

At the meeting of the Board of Directors held today, Japan Cash Machine Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") resolved to revise its dividend policy and revise its dividend forecast (increase in dividends) for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2027. The details are as follows.

1. Revision of Dividend Policy

The Company recognizes the return of profits to shareholders as one of its important management priorities. The Company's basic policy on the distribution of profit is to strike a balance between two aspects; to increase dividend payment amount as a result of a profit increase through the realization of growth strategies and to return a profit to shareholders through the payment of stable dividends.

Under this policy, the Company had previously determined dividends based on "a consolidated dividend payout ratio of 30 % or more by taking into account the ratio of dividends to net assets." However, based on the medium-term management plan "JCM Global Vision 2032 -Next Growth Stage-" through the fiscal year ending March 31, 2029, announced today, and in light of the Company's efforts to expand its business performance, the Company has decided to revise its dividend policy to "a consolidated dividend payout ratio of 50% or more" in order to further enhance returns to shareholders.

2. Revision of Dividend Forecast

(1) Reason for the Revision

Regarding the dividend forecast for the current fiscal year ending March 31, 2027, based on the above revision of the dividend policy, the Company has decided to revise both the second-quarter-end (interim) dividend and the year-end dividend by increasing each by 3 yen to 23 yen per share, resulting in an annual dividend of 46 yen per share.
