Subsidiary, Antalis**

We hereby announce that Antalis GmbH (located in Frechen, Germany), an operating company of Antalis S.A.S. (located in Paris, France, “Antalis”), which is a consolidated subsidiary of the Company, has acquired all shares of Speidel GmbH (located in Illingen, Germany; “Speidel”), which engages in the packaging business in Germany.

1. Reason for the Share Acquisition

Speidel is based in the state of Baden-Württemberg in southwestern Germany. Since its establishment in 1981, the company has developed particular strengths in custom-made packaging that combines highly durable large-format corrugated cardboard, foam, wood and other materials, especially for the delivery of heavy goods. Over the past 45 years, Speidel has built a solid business foundation through transactions with companies across a wide range of industries, including medical devices, automation machinery, metal processing and automotive, supported by its specialized order made proposal capabilities developed through close collaboration with customers and its solution-oriented approach.

KPP Group is working to transform its business portfolio by expanding into the packaging business and the visual communication business. Antalis is pursuing the same strategy, and in Germany, a large-scale market, it is particularly focused on expanding its business foundation in packaging. This transaction follows the acquisition of the BB Pack Group in 2022, which has strengths in the e-commerce field, and Hein Verpackungen GmbH in March 2026, which has strengths in small and lightweight

packaging for manufacturers of daily consumer goods, automobiles, electronics and other products. The transaction forms part of Antalis' diversification strategy in the packaging business, where growth is expected in the German market. Through this transaction, Antalis expects to strengthen its customer base in Germany, enhance its product development capabilities, expand its ability to propose packaging solutions offering through the in-house integration of converter functions for heavy-duty large-format corrugated packaging, and improve its revenue and cost structure.
