## February 2016: MONTHLY DISCLOSURE

Annualized premium of new business was 105 million yen, 102% of February 2015

TOKYO, March 7, 2016 – LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President & COO Daisuke Iwase, URL: <u>http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/</u>) announces the monthly business performance for February 2016.

Annualized premium<sup>\*1</sup> of new business in the month of February 2016 was 105 million yen (102% of February 2015). The number of applications was 2,806 (93% of February 2015), with the number of new business at 2,252 (101% of February 2015). Accordingly, annualized premium<sup>\*1</sup> of policies-in-force was 9,320 million yen. The number of policies-in-force as of the end of February 2016 resulted in a total of 224,431, and sum insured of policies-in-force stands at 1,900,281 million yen.

In February 2016, insurance premiums and claims and benefits recorded 769 million yen (107% of February 2015) and 72 million yen (120% of February 2015), respectively.
