## **FY2018 1Q: INSURANCE PAYMENTS REPORT**

**1,628 payments for 1Q of FY2018**

TOKYO, July 17, 2018 - LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President Ryosuke Mori, URL: <http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/>) announces a report on the number of insurance payments for the first quarter of fiscal 2018, ending March 31, 2019.

The number of insurance payments made in the first quarter of fiscal 2018 resulted in 1,628 cases, 22 of which were insurance claims and the remaining 1,606 benefit claims. Meanwhile, there were 62 incidents which were assessed to be inapplicable.

Lifenet believes the most important responsibility for an insurance company is to make claim payments accurately and without delay, and we thrive to continue to accomplish this. Lifenet makes every effort to ensure payment of insurance claims and benefits are made to the designated account within 5 business days\*<sup>1</sup> of receiving all necessary documents. In the first quarter of fiscal 2018, the insurance payment was made in 2.41 business days\*<sup>1</sup> in average.

During the first quarter of fiscal 2018, the number of claimants who were paid disability benefits was 28.
