1. Overview of Operating Results

(1) Overview of Operating Results

During the first half of the current fiscal year (the six months from April 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025), the economic outlook remained uncertain due to the continued instability of the international situation and other factors.

MEITEC (MT) and MEITEC Fielders (MF), which are responsible for the Engineering Solutions Business that accounts for more than 90% of the Group's consolidated net sales, saw orders and utilization ratios remain strong as leading manufacturers that constitute the Group's major clients invested in technological development focused on the next generation of products. Due to challenges in recruitment, the number of engineers (total for MT and MF) as of September 30, 2025 decreased slightly year on year to 12,393 (down 119, or -1.0% compared to September 30, 2024). The utilization ratio remained at the same level year on year as a result of assignments of new employees and existing employees in response to orders. Furthermore, working hours decreased slightly year on year, mainly due to a decrease in overtime work.

As a result, consolidated net sales for the period under review increased ¥2,514 million, or 3.8%, from a year earlier to ¥68,352 million. Consolidated cost of sales increased ¥1,880 million, or 3.9%, from a year earlier to ¥50,091 million, due mainly to an increase in labor expenses, and consolidated selling, general and administrative expenses decreased ¥408 million, or 4.8%, from a year earlier to ¥8,197 million. As a result, consolidated operating profit increased ¥1,043 million, or 11.6%, from a year earlier to ¥10,063 million, and consolidated ordinary profit increased ¥1,124 million, or 12.4%, from a year earlier to ¥10,172 million. Profit attributable to owners of parent increased ¥1,395 million, or 25.2%, from a year earlier to ¥6,933 million, as a result of having recorded impairment losses of ¥620 million in the previous fiscal year associated with the suspension of use of a large training facility owned by the Company.

(2) Overview of Financial Position

Total consolidated assets at the end of the 1st half (September 30, 2025) decreased \(\frac{4}{6}, 593 \) million from March 31, 2025 to \(\frac{4}{87}, 012 \) million. This reflected a decrease of \(\frac{4}{6}, 837 \) million in current assets from the previous fiscal yearend as a result of a decrease in cash and deposits. Furthermore, the main factors for the decrease in cash and deposits were payment of bonuses, income taxes payable and year-end dividends of the previous fiscal year.

Total consolidated liabilities as of September 30, 2025 decreased \(\frac{4}{4}\),986 million from March 31, 2025 to \(\frac{4}{3}\)9,842 million. This reflected a decrease of \(\frac{4}{5}\),184 million in current liabilities from the previous fiscal year-end. The decrease in current liabilities was primarily due to a decrease in accrued consumption taxes included in other in current liabilities.

Total consolidated net assets as of September 30, 2025 decreased ¥1,606 million from March 31, 2025 to ¥47,170 million. This mainly reflected an increase in profit attributable to owners of parent due to business performance in the period under review, offset by the payment of dividends.

(3) Explanation of Consolidated Earnings Forecasts and other Forward-looking Statements

Having revised key indicators for the Engineering Solutions Business taking into account prevailing trends, the Company has accordingly revised its consolidated forecasts released on May 8, 2025.
