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1. Summary of business results

(1) Summary of business results during the period under review

During the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review (April 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025), the Japanese economy exhibited resilience, with employment and income supported by the ripple effects of wage increases and inbound demand.

However, the prolonged surge in prices led to stagnation of nominal personal consumption, while slowing exports, affected by US trade policies, capped growth, resulting in a modest economic recovery. Looking ahead, continuing vigilance in monitoring the impact on the Japanese economy of the downside risks posed by overseas economies, mounting geopolitical tensions, and trends and fluctuations in financial and capital markets will be needed.

In such an economic environment, the performance in the used vehicle market, the Company's main target, was up from the previous year, with a total of 2,653,155 vehicles registered in Japan from April 2025 through September 2025 (ordinary passenger vehicles, compact passenger vehicles, and mini four-wheeled passenger vehicles), an increase of 1.5% year-on-year. Based on the assumption of thoroughgoing compliance tailored to changes in the external business environment, including regulatory changes, our Group seeks to realize our mission of contributing to establishing a prosperous society by providing top-level financing and services to the world and of fostering employees who are broadminded, have a positive outlook, and work assiduously to generate results. In addition to credit finance and automobile warranty services, to expand business interactions and accelerate growth in the scope of our operations and earnings, we provide a comprehensive line of automobility services that assist used vehicle dealers and auto repair shops, our major client base, in related vehicle procedures they undertake. We are also tackling the challenge of implementing various initiatives to realize a new growth model.

Summarized below is the status of each business during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review. The results shown exclude operating revenues from internal sales between segments.

The Finance Business saw a temporary suspension of new applications due to the rollback to the old system, prioritization of debt collection operations, and an interest rate rise, resulting in a temporary slowdown in loan volume growth. On the other hand, efforts to retain customers involving inducements to join the Car Premium Club membership program and support system improvements achieved by adding more back-office personnel proved effective. As a result, loan volume slightly exceeded that of the previous year, with operating revenue reaching 11,787 million yen (up 15.0% year-on-year) and operating profit of 1,998 million yen (down 33.9% year-on-year).

In the Automotive Warranty Business, energetic efforts to attract customers to the Car Premium Club membership program and revised product offerings for OEM partners proved successful. The resulting volume of automotive warranties once again exceeded that of the previous year, resulting in operating revenue of 3,860 million yen, a 13.6% year-on-year increase. Operating profit rose to 599 million yen (a 26.0% year-on-year increase), reflecting continued cost reduction initiatives, including the expansion of higher-margin proprietary (i.e., directly-provided) warranty products.

In the Automobility Services Business, in addition to steady growth in the Car Premium Club and subscription (lease) services, improvements in operating revenue and profit due to the resolution of order-to-delivery timing gaps in software sales, improvements in inventory turnover, and rigorous pricing discipline in vehicle sales contributed to recovery in gross profit across each business. These factors resulted in operating revenue of 5,104 million yen (up 14.9% year on year) and operating profit of 839 million yen (up 44.1% year on year).

Operating expenses were 17,331 million yen (up 23.4% year-on-year) due to successful efforts to reduce expenses, such as by DX promotion and cost reduction in the Automobile Warranty Business. This success helped offset the increase in expenses associated with system-related and other costs.

These factors resulted in operating revenue during the cumulative period through the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review of 20,888 million yen (up 15.5% year-on-year); operating profit of 3,556 million yen (down 12.2% year-on-year); profit for the term before tax of 3,730 million yen (down 8.5% year-on-year); and profit for the term attributable to owners of the parent of 2,589 million yen (down 6.6% year-on-year).

(2) Summary of financial position during the period under review

1) Status of assets, liabilities and equity

(Assets)

At the end of the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total assets stood at 188,943 million yen, up 3,955 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 7,002 million yen in cash and cash equivalents, 4,271 million yen in financial receivables, and declines of 5,445 million yen in other assets and 2,206 million yen in insurance assets.

(Liabilities)

At the end of the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total liabilities stood at 166,051 million yen, up 12 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 19,593 million yen in borrowings, as well as a decline of 17,730 million yen in financial guarantee contracts and 2,121 million yen in other financial liabilities.

(Equity)

At the end of the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total equity stood at 22,892 million yen, up 3,944 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 1,828 million yen in retained earnings. Total equity attributable to owners of parent grew 3,949 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year to 22,871 million yen.

2) Status of cash flows

A look at cash flow during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review shows expenditures of 12,765 million yen from operating activities (vs. revenue of 103 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year); expenditures of 467 million yen from investing activities (vs. expenditures of 1,269 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year); and revenue of 20,226 million yen from financing activities (vs. expenditures of 1,714 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year). Cash and cash equivalents ("funds" hereinafter) at the end of the consolidated fiscal year under review stood at 24,148 million yen.

The status of each cash flow and contributing factors during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review are as follows.

(Cash flow from operating activities)

Funds used in sales activities during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 12,765 million. Major revenue was profit for the term before tax of 3,730 million yen. Depreciation and amortization amounted to 1,076 million yen. Major expenses included a decline of 17,730 million yen in financial guarantee contracts.

(Cash flow from investing activities)

Funds diverted to investments during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 467 million yen. Major revenues from investing activities included proceeds of 342 million yen from the sale of property, plant and equipment; major expenditures included 514 million yen for the acquisition of property, plant, and equipment, 203 million yen for the acquisition of intangible assets, and 124 million yen for the acquisition of equity-method investments.

(Cash flow from financing activities)

Funds acquired through financing activities during the first half of this consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 20,226 million yen. Major revenues from financing activities included 28,413 million yen from long-term borrowings and 1,764 million yen from the disposal of treasury shares. Major expenditures included 8,846 million yen in repayment of long-term borrowings.

Consolidated earnings forecasts are based on the information currently available, and actual results may differ
from forecasts due to various factors in the future. At this time, the full-year earnings forecasts published in the
"Consolidated Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2025 [IFRS]" on May 15, 2025, remain
unchanged.

(Segment information)

(1) General information on reporting segments

The Group's reporting segments consist of the Group's constituent units for which separate financial information is available and subject to periodic review by the Board of Directors for decisions related to allocating management resources and evaluating business performance.

The Group reports in three segments: the Finance Business, Automobile Warranty Business, and Automobility Services Business.

A summary of each reporting segment is provided below.

The Finance Business consists mainly of the Credit Finance Business and Auto Leasing Business, which provide financing services to enable customers to pay for purchases of products and services in installments, and the debt collection services.

The Automobile Warranty Business consists of automobile warranty services that enable customers who choose to add automobile warranty plans when they purchase vehicles through Group partners to obtain repairs free of charge, within the scope specified in advance, for mechanical problems affecting their purchased vehicles, in exchange for payment of a fixed warranty fee.

The Automobility Services Business is made up chiefly of automobility services, which are multiple services useful in operating the automobile distribution business (e.g., the membership-based network business, auto leasing business, vehicle wholesaling, and automotive parts and software sales).

The Group does not allocate assets and liabilities to the business segments employed by the Board of Directors.

(2) Profit or loss by reporting segment

The Group's figures for profit or loss by segment are, in principle, prepared using the same standards as those for consolidated financial statements. Adjustments include elimination entries for internal transactions between segments. Prices of internal transactions between segments are based on actual market prices.
